The **71st General Assembly of the CIC** will take place in **Doha, Qatar**, a city built on diplomacy, dialogue, and exchange. **Mediation** is the central theme of this year's gathering—how hunters act as mediators in the field, balancing conservation with land use, working alongside **foresters, landowners, and the agricultural sector**. At the same time, hunting itself requires mediation—navigating public perception, engaging with journalists, policymakers, and civil society to ensure sustainable use is understood and valued.

Day 1: Mediation in Hunting and Conservation

Hunters are on the ground where conservation and land use intersect. Whether resolving conflicts between agriculture and wildlife, shaping sustainable use policies, or building cooperation between sectors, their role as mediators is critical. This day will focus on how hunting contributes to conservation diplomacy and stakeholder dialogue.

Day 2: Falconry – Tradition, Culture, and Conservation

On Day 2, the focus shifts to falconry, a UNESCO-recognized Intangible Cultural Heritage and a longstanding tradition in the region. Doha, a global centre for falconry, provides the perfect setting to explore its cultural significance, conservation role, and future in a changing world. This year's theme builds on last year's "Bridges to Biodiversity" and aligns with the CIC 2030 Strategic Plan, reinforcing CIC's commitment to collaboration, sustainable use, and hunter-led conservation.
